A special appeal from Marc Easton, our Forest School leader

In June of this year (and last year too), I was lucky to go on holiday to the beautiful Caribbean island of Dominica (not to be confused with Dominican Republic) where I made great friends within the local communities.

You may have seen the news footage of Hurricane Maria and the terrible impact that it has had on Dominica and its people. The island has been stripped of its trees, plants and rainforests, houses, businesses and schools have been destroyed and people have lost loved ones and their worldly possessions.









Many international and regional organisations have been delivering immediate aid such as food, water, tools etc and I am travelling to Dominica myself on 19th October, the day after Forest School, to deliver donated items for children to replace some of their lost clothes, toys and books and help with the clearing up and rebuilding.

It would be wonderful if Twineham School and parents were able to help by donating items of children's clothing such as t-shirts, shorts, summer dresses, sandals, flip flops etc., small toys, reading books (not hardback), children's playing cards etc., it would be very much appreciated.
