# Safeguarding Spot

As you all know a public footpath runs between the school building and our playground and field. With the start of a brand new year, we have been reminding all the children of how we keep safe, with this in mind.

Here are some of the things we do:

Staff all have lanyards on and will be wearing Hi-Vis jackets when on the playground and field. This ensures that children can quickly spot a member of staff if they need help.

All staff will always speak to any adults on the school grounds that are not wearing a high vis/ lanyard to check if we can help them (please don't be offended if we don't all recognise everyone)

The green gate is kept shut at all times apart from playtimes and drop offs and pick ups, when it is monitored by a member of staff.

You can also help our school community keep safe by:

- Always closing the green gate behind you
- Letting us know if you have any concerns or ideas
- Talking to your child about how they stay safe at school.
- Asking your child who their 'trusted adults' are at school that they can go and talk to if they have worries or feel upset.
