Details about who are selling when are included at the end of this email, if you need a reminder.

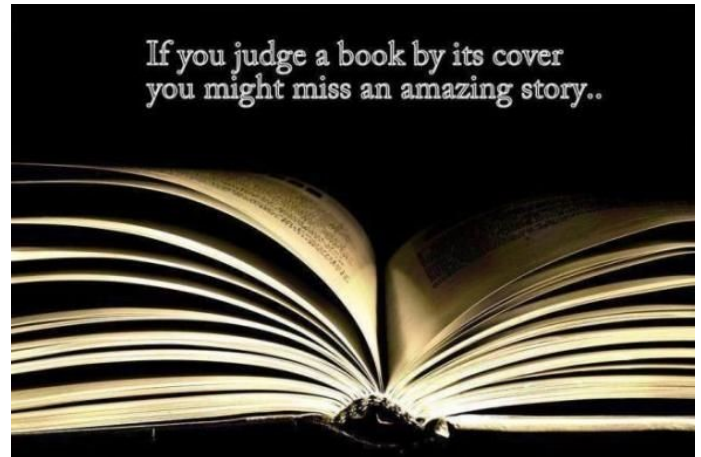


Worship Spot

Young Entrepreneur Buying & Selling Details!

For the buyers –

Stalls will be out on the large playground on Tuesday and Thursday this week and next week after school. **Please do not send your child into school with any money**, they will only be able to buy items after school with your permission. There will also be opportunities to sign up and pay for lessons on these days, such as for drumming and art (the lessons will then take place during lunchtimes).

For the sellers -

Thank you for all your proposals and the thought that has gone into these. If your child is running a business please read the following details carefully...

ALL businesses can run a stall this Tuesday (24th) from 3-3.30pm. Parents, if possible please keep items at home, and bring them in at 2.50 ready to set up. If this not possible we have a small amount of storage in the office, but all items need to be in a named bag/box. Any items not sold should go home (and not be left in school) until your child's next selling day.

Following on from Tuesday's whole school sale we will have 3 more sales with *different children selling on each day*. We have taken into account the variety of businesses, and are aiming to avoid multiple sales of the same on item on any one day for example.
