Dear Parents/ Carers,



If you are concerned about your child's learning or well-being at any time...

Please always speak to your class teacher first.

All our teachers are experienced working with children with a wide range of needs. As stated in West Sussex's guidance (Ordinarily Available Inclusive Practice) "Every practitioner is a teacher of SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities)". Best practice in all schools is that teachers provide individualised and targeted support in class, wherever possible. The SENDCO (Special Educational Needs Coordinator) provides support to the teachers to do this and to access further support as needed. We will always consult parents before accessing any external support.

We know that if your child has identified additional needs it can be a minefield to find out what support is available. We are hoping to put together a short leaflet to explain how we can support in school and to signpost to other organisations.
