Physical Education and Sport at Twineham: Update from Mrs Stafford

Now that we are comfortably into the summer term, I wanted to let you know what we have planned for PE, Physical Activity and School Sport at Twineham.









You will already have received the curriculum plan but I wanted to let you know what other activities and events we had planned (weather permitting!).

We have entered the **Mid Sussex School Marathon** again. This involves every child running/walking 1 mile. We are aiming to complete this challenge on Friday 21st May. The following week the Sports Crew are designing a day of activities for the whole school. In the morning, they will run an event for **Buttercups** and **Poppy** class. In the afternoon, they will run an event for **Willow** and **Oakwood**. In order for the Sports Crew to participate in the activities, Poppy class are going to step up to the challenge of leading KS2!

Following this there will then be an opportunity for Oakwood to participate in **the Sussex Virtual School Games Quad Kids** event. They will compete in four events and the top five scores for boys and girls will be submitted as the Team Twineham scores.

After half-term, we already have our **Day of Sport** planned. We are also planning to have a **Sports Day** in July – more details soon, as we are awaiting further DfE guidance for how this will work.

I hope you agree that all of the above, plus the coaching provided by Sussex Cricket and the after-school clubs we are running, mean that our children have great opportunities to be physically active and to learn and develop their skills.
